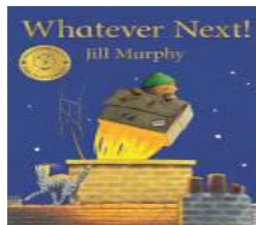

Learning Areas:

EYFS: Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

This half term we will be focusing on sharing our learning with our friends by exploring several fun activities. We will become active learners by independently choosing a range of materials to explore our own creations.

We will be touching on these questions when we start our topic on Space.

What would it feel like to be in Space? Who would we want to take with us? Have you ever stayed away from home? Where did you go?

What would you take with you to space? Would you miss your family and friends?

Which planet would you travel to and why?

How would you travel to space? What would you wear?

EYFS: Communication and Language, Literacy, Speaking.

During this topic on 'Space', we will develop our understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting the correct picture. The children will also respond to simple instructions and begin to understand how and why questions.

We will build up vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences.

During story time, the children will join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.

We will also play lots of language games such as guess who? What's in my space bag? and the remembering game- When I went to the moon, I took.....

The children will go on a space adventure and pack a bag ready for their journey to infinity and beyond!!!

EYFS: Literacy, Reading and Writing

We will be focusing on a range of texts and describing the main story settings, events, and principal characters. We will listen to the stories, repeat, and recall the key parts.

The children will give meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint.

They will sequence stories related to the topic and act out their favourite part.

The children will make log- books, space pop up cards, moon dust phonics, space passports and much more.

EYFS: Mathematics-Numbers, Shape, Space and Measures

We will be looking at a range of Math's games related to the topic such as- making shape rockets, aliens, and planets. Taking away 5/10 little men in a flying saucer and adding games.

We will be counting backwards from 10-1 Blast Off!! In addition, sequencing alien numbers to 5, 10 and 20.

We will focus on counting, formation of numbers and matching numbers to the correct quantity. It is going to be a blast!

EYFS: Expressive Arts and Design.

We will be using a variety of skills and crafts to create a wide range of art and design throughout this topic. We will be making jet packs, rockets, clay aliens, flying saucers, moonscape, marble art and lots more. The children will begin to be interested in and describe the texture of things, using various construction materials. In Dance, the children will use movement to express their feelings to the galaxy music. During story time, they will use available resources to create props to support role-play. We will also capture experiences and responses with a range of media, such as music, dance and painting and other materials or words.

EYFS: Understanding the World People & Community, The World Technology.

This exciting topic encourages the children to explore a range of media and textures.

We will be exploring a range of questions such as:

How do we eat in space? Wash our hair? Brush our teeth? Sleep in space. How long does it take to get to space? What would you need to take to breathe in space?

The children will learn about the solar system through the planet rap song and act it out.

They will discuss the planets' temperature, hot colours, cold colours, rings and comets.

In ICT/technology, we will use Space virtual glasses and pretend to be walking on the moon.

Using interactive games on the whiteboard, iPad

EYFS: Physical Development.

This half term KG will be continuing to work on their fine and gross motor skills through a variety of activities. They will be experimenting with different ways of moving in PE, negotiating space successfully and adjusting speed or direction to avoid obstacles. They will be having fun with our Space obstacle course and dancing to sticky kids.

Mr. Makin will focus on movement through music to explore moving like an astronaut on the moon and zooming like a rocket. He will also be doing an exercise alphabet linked to space. We will also work on our pencil grip through finger gym activities and sensory play. The children will practise pencil control and work on the formation of letters.
